Regulations for free attempts for Master's study programmes (as from the Framework University and Framework Examination Regulations 2016)

I did not pass an exam at the first attempt and would like to make an application for a free attempt, how do I do that?

After your first examination attempt, you can apply for a free attempt at the Student Support Service 4 weeks before the start of the next examination period, if the examination was taken within the official study period on the official examination date (according to the curriculum). The regulations for free attempts only apply in regard to module examinations from the first two semesters. If you are prevented from taking an examination (e.g., through illness, de-registration or holiday), you lose the option of the free attempt because it is reliant on taking the examination on the official examination date.

I have passed an examination, however, I would like to improve my grade. When can I make use of an improvement attempt?

A passed module examination may be repeated in order to improve the grade if you passed this examination at the first attempt and on the official examination date within the official study period. The regulations for free attempts only apply in regard to module examinations from the first two semesters.

An attempt to improve the grade can also be applied for at the Student Support Service **4 weeks** before the start of the next examination period.

What happens if I do not pass the improvement attempt or get a worse grade?

The best grade will always be counted.

How often can I make use of a free attempt and/or an attempt to improve the grade?

Students in Master's study programmes may make use of this regulation once.
 That means that you can make use of either one free attempt or one attempt to improve the grade during your degree.

What do you need to know?

- 1. Only one application per module is possible. Sub-modules use up one attempt (application).
- 2. The examination concerned must be passed within the two semesters following the attempt.
- 3. De-registration or non-attendance of the requested examination attempt without permission means the options of the free attempt and the attempt to improve the grade cannot be used
- 4. Please inform the Student Support Service as soon as the grade for the free attempt is entered into the individual results.
