



## STIBET - I – SCHOLARSHIPS

### FOR FINALISING STUDIES / FOR HIGHLY COMMITTED STUDENTS

The EUSD call for international students for the DAAD scholarships within the STIBET-I - programme is now open. These DAAD scholarships are financed by the Federal Foreign Office (Auswärtiges Amt). You can apply for one or both of the listed scholarships.

**Application deadline for  
both scholarships**

15 October 2020

**You can apply if you ...**

- are regularly enrolled at EUSD (no exchange students)
- are not in possession of the German citizenship
- obtained your higher education entrance qualification at a school abroad (this includes German schools abroad) or
- obtained your Bachelor's degree at a foreign university or
- have supplemented school qualifications acquired abroad with a German Studienkolleg

**STIBET - I - SCHOLARSHIP

**Funding prerequisites  
and selection criteria**

- good educational performance and an expected successful completion of studies within one year
- foreign students who are in distress without their own fault should be given the opportunity to concentrate on their studies and graduation
- master students from 3<sup>rd</sup> semester onwards, bachelor students from 5<sup>th</sup> semester onwards

**Extent and duration of  
funding**

This scholarship can be granted for up to six months; at the EUSD the funding period is usually 1-2 months due to limited funds. The monthly subsidy is at least 250 €.

**Funding prerequisites  
and selection criteria**

- good educational achievements
- remarkable engagement in an international context at EUSD (not older than two years); this engagement could be the participation in the IFSA, Horizonte e.V., the language café or active work in the Buddy team (among others)

**Extent and duration of  
funding**

This scholarship can be granted for up to six months; at the EUSD the funding period is usually 1-2 months due to limited funds. The monthly subsidy is at least 250 €.

### Documents for a complete application

- Application Form
- Letter of Motivation, max. 1-2 pages; please use the template “letter of motivation”
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- current certificate of enrolment of EUSD
- declaration of consent to retrieve a current transcript of records by the Student Support Service Department
- if applicable, evidence(s) of aspects mentioned in the letter of motivation or curriculum vitae proving eligibility (e.g. commitment in an international context)
- Timetable for the completion of your Bachelor´s – or Master´s thesis including milestones when applying for a scholarship for finalising studies
