

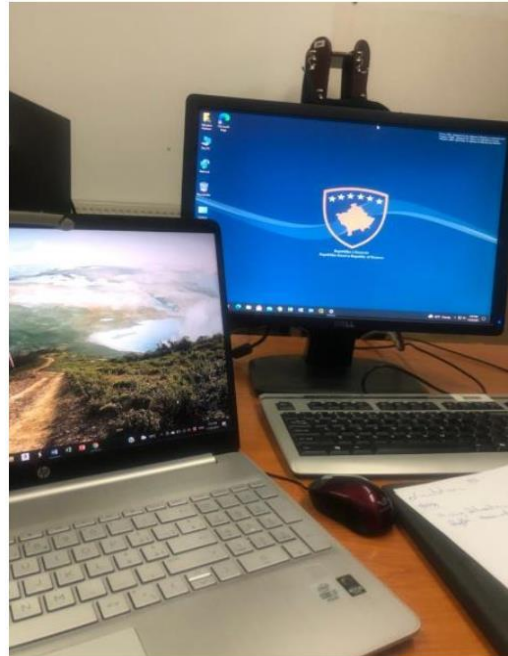
STORYTELLING ABOUT MY INTERNSHIP ABROAD WITH ERASMUS+ Support

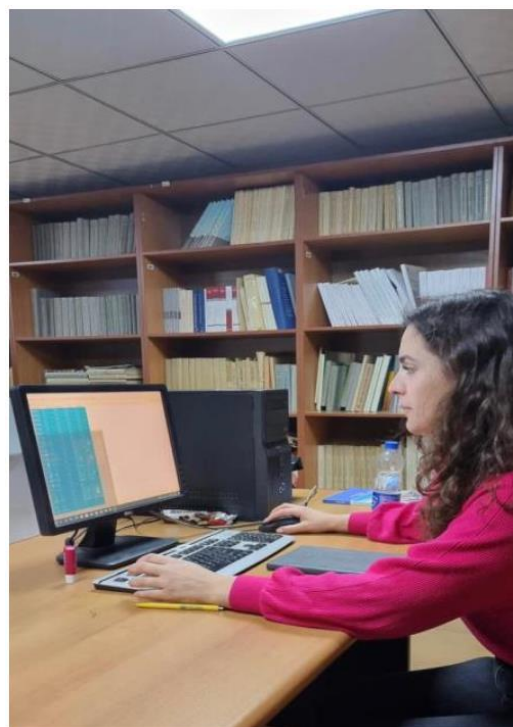
Why did you decide to study abroad as part of your studies?
