What you should check beforehand in order to be prepared for your virtual (and in some cases even on-site) participation in your study programme:

- You should have a stable and ideally fast internet connection
- Try to connect your computer physically to the internet and do not use WIFI whenever possible
- Please keep your computer connected with the power supply, the online-services we use for our lectures, seminars, etc. consume a lot of energy and even if your battery has still some energy, the video and audio quality will suffer significantly and will not last long...
- It is highly advisable to use a headset at home or on-site in Eberswalde
- If you are participating on-site in Eberswalde, please bring your personal notebook, power supply and headset.
