You are entitled at any time in accordance with Art. 15 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) to request full information on data stored concerning you from the General Students' Committee of HNE Eberswalde.

In accordance with Art. 17 of the GDPR, you may demand the correction, deletion or blockage of parts of your personal data by the General Students' Committee of HNE Eberswalde.

You may also exercise your right of objection at any time, without citing grounds, and amend your informed consent or revoke it entirely with regard to any future usage. You may express your objection either by post, e-mail or fax to your contractual partner. No costs are incurred beyond the postage or forwarding according to existing base rates.

Checklist for the application to the SoliTicketFund (annex)

Copies of the following documents must be submitted in the following order (please tick off)
(Originals are to be submitted on request if necessary)

- completed and signed application form for support from the SoliTicketFund
- certificate of matriculation (download via "My EMMA" / certificates)
- university certificate of payment of the semester fee (download via "My EMMA" / certificates)

Proof of income

- BAföG decision or conclusive, meaningful explanation why the applicant does not receive or has not applied for BAföG**
- housing allowance notice or conclusive, meaningful explanation why the applicant does not receive or has not applied for housing allowance**
- and all other notifications of income (educational loans, scholarships, ...)

** in principle, only those who have demonstrably made an effort to obtain support from the relevant authorities are entitled to receive money from the SoliTicketFund. It should be noted that applications from applicants who do not apply for or make use of public benefits to which they are entitled (BAföG, social benefits, housing benefit) on their own responsibility will be rejected.

Proof of expenditure

- rental agreement (in case of shared rental costs, a confirmation from the co-tenant) or proof of expenses for rent and household operating and service charges
- account statements from 3 full months before application (from all accounts)
 - account transactions not related to the application can be blacked out
 - be recognizable in the statement and must be marked:
 - current account balance
 - wage payments
 - other income (support payments from parents, child benefit, etc.)
 - rent and service charge payments (gas, electricity, possibly house cleaning, broadcasting fees)
 - health insurance contribution payments
 - other expenses to be claimed (e.g. current loan instalments paid)
 - all other amounts to be claimed

child allowances

- if applicable: birth certificate of the child(ren) (for crediting the corresponding allowances)

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Guide to the SoliTicketFund application (doesn't need to be printed out)

The SoliTicketFund is a solidarity fund from which students with special needs can be supported in financing their studies by the student body of the HNEE through a contribution to the semester ticket fee.

Where and how to submit?

- applications must be submitted **in printed form** and addressed to the ASStA of the HNE (postal mail/delivery at the ASStA office/ drop in the mailbox of the HNE mail office)
- **The deadline is the arrival of the application documents at the HNE**

Application deadlines

summer semester: **01.03. – 30.04.**
winter semester: **01.09. – 31.10.**

Applications submitted after this deadline can no longer be considered!!!

Further information on the calculation of indigence

The following maximum amounts are included in the calculation:

- the maximum disposable income after deduction of eligible expenses must not exceed € 446.00 (with the maximum amounts the ASStA orients itself at the annual Hartz IV standard rate and the current rent levels of Berlin and Brandenburg, these limits are regularly checked and adjusted)
- net rent max. € 275 per adult living in Brandenburg and € 450,00 living in Berlin (the allowance increases by € 75,00 per child)
- the amount of the protected assets is max. € 200 per completed year of life of the applicant (€ 150 per child up to 18 years and year of age)

Explanation of the calculation

For calculation purposes, all relevant income of the applicant is determined based on the information in the tables above. From the sum of your income, the sum of all costs from the information provided in the tables is deducted (of course only if they are paid by yourself). **All applicants are held to disclose their income and financial circumstances truthfully.**

Applicants who have assets in **blocked accounts**, of which only a certain maximum amount is available each month, please indicate this monthly rate under "other income".

Please note, that some sections of the application for might not necessarily be applicable for international exchange students.
