

Data Literacy: Assessing sources and data

criterium	explanation
target group	Who is the target audience for the document - lay people or peer groups?
authorship	Are authors indicated and what is known about them? Can they be assigned to a scientific or other renowned institution? Is there an imprint about the people or institutions responsible for the publication? Has the publication been reviewed by members of the peer group (peer reviewed)?
relevancy	When was the document published? For websites: when was it last updated?
content	Is the issue discussed scientifically or superficially? Is the topic presented objectively?
stylistics	How is the presentation - clearly structured and clear? Is navigating easy and understandably? Is the content supported by graphics or examples? What is the language and choice of words (specialist or general language)? Are orthography and spelling correct?
verifiability	Are the sources named? Are citations marked and verified? Is there a bibliography?
